Letter to MPs

It is best to use your own words in writing, but you may find this template useful as a starting point.

Dear XXX

I am writing as your constituent to ask you to take a stand against the now clearly demonstrated law-breaking and lying to Parliament by the Prime Minister and the Chancellor.

Breaking important Covid-19 pandemic laws they themselves had put in place to reduce transmission, save lives, and protect the NHS, by attending and thereby endorsing frequent illegal parties, breaks all codes of conduct. Doing so while knowingly issuing fines of up to £10,000 per person elsewhere, demonstrates a belief that they are above the law. Repeatedly lying, on record, before parliament, about not breaking them is in clear breach of the Ministerial code.

I believe that it is your duty as an MP to uphold Parliamentary standards and am asking you now to write to Sir Graham Brady, Chairman of the 1922 Committee, to call for a vote of no confidence in the Prime Minister.
